

## The Somerset Early Help Assessment (EHA) Important information!

There are some changes around Early Help and the Early Help Assessment (EHA), including processes, with immediate effect. Read below for a brief outline of these changes.

### Early Help Assessment - registration changes

With immediate effect, you **no longer** need to register EHAs with the Early Help Hub.

The decision not to register EHAs is supported by the Early Help Board. It will give staff in the hub more capacity to support practitioners in the field who are working with families.
